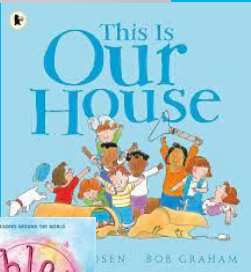

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be:

- Participating in turn taking games
- Trying out new activities and selecting resources independently.
- Learning routines of the day
- Learning to think about our own feelings and the feelings of others.
- Talking about our families and other people who are important to us.

Communication and Language

We will be:

- Having lots of conversations with adult and our friends.
- Talking about our families and other people who are important to us.
- Learning to answer questions about ourselves.
- Learning how to describe ourselves using short sentences by looking in a 'magic mirror'.

Physical Development

We will be:

- Discussing healthy practices and ways to keep healthy.
- Supporting each other to wash hands before snack time/after using the toilet.
- Exploring equipment in our garden and practicing going over, under and through it to develop our control and coordination.
- Using a range of malleable materials such as playdough and clay to models.

Autumn Term 1 This is me!

Literacy

We will be:

- Learning to recognise and write our names.
- Reading a range of fiction books such as the Invisible String and the Colour Monster.
- Learning different sounds that letters make (phonics)
- Learning to draw ourselves, our families and friends using a range of media including pencils, paints and chinks.

Mathematics

We will be:

- Learning number songs to help us with our early counting skills.
- Exploring capacity in the water area.
- Exploring shape and measures by measuring ingredients for baking.
- Learning positional language to describe where we, and objects are in a range of games.

Understanding the World

We will be:

- Recognising similarities and differences between each other, looking at pictures of ourselves as babies and now.
- Going on local walks around the school and visiting the local Library.
- Learning about different parts of our bodies. .
- Exploring our fingerprints and comparing them with others.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be:

- Learning songs related to the body such as Head, shoulders, knees and toes.
- Roleplaying in the home corner.
- Using a range of materials and loose parts to create faces and talking about our features.
- We will have access to a range of materials to create models and pictures and explore textures.
