To support and enable services working with children to adopt tooth-friendly practices.

Who can take part in Healthy Smiles?

The local authority commissions our oral health promotion team to deliver the programme to early years settings in targeted areas.

- Nurseries
- Preschools
- Children's Centres
- Special schools

What does the accreditation involve?

There are 5 standards around oral health, including:

- Promoting local dentist information and registration
- Providing tooth friendly snacks
- How the setting celebrates birthdays and other celebrations encouraging families to bring in tooth friendly items instead of sweets and cake
- Staff receive annual Healthy Smiles training
- Supervised toothbrushing



Supervised toothbrushing

- Support and training from the team for the start up of the tooth brushing programme
- -In depth training for cross infection control and guidelines given.
- -Ongoing support visit after 1 month
